## Range/Property/Forestry Report:

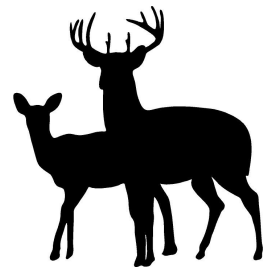

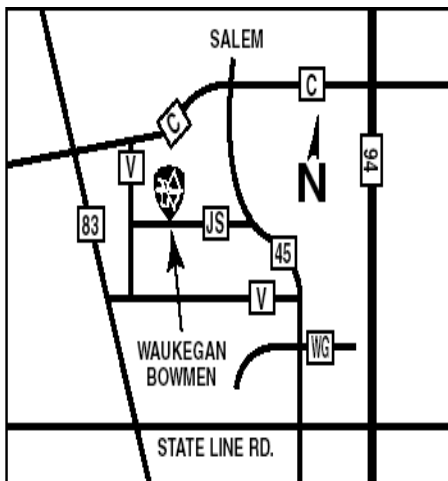
