INSTRUCTIONS**

Answer all questions completely. Please print or type all answers. Big game is as defined by the Waukegan Bowmen. Eligibility for awards: To Waukegan Bowmen Members in good standing only. Award per kill per state according to state or provincial hunting laws. Big game must be taken under the Pope & Young Rules of Fair Chase (excluding game farm kills). Anyone wishing to have whitetail or mule deer does compete for the Big Doe Award must attach a legal locker weight slip with the signature of the weigher and address of locker, feed store, market, etc. The Big Buck Award will pertain to Whitetail Buck Deer only. The winner will be determined by the Pope & Young scoring system and measured by any official Pope & Young measurer. To be eligible for any award this application must be received by the Vice President no later than the January meeting!

The Pope & Young scoring system will be used to determine the largest mule deer buck and the winner's name will be engraved on the club's mule deer buck trophy.

For the Big Bear Trophy the Pope & Young scoring system will apply to determine the winner. Any species of big game are eligible for Waukegan Bowmen Big Game Pins. Awards will be given at the banquet.

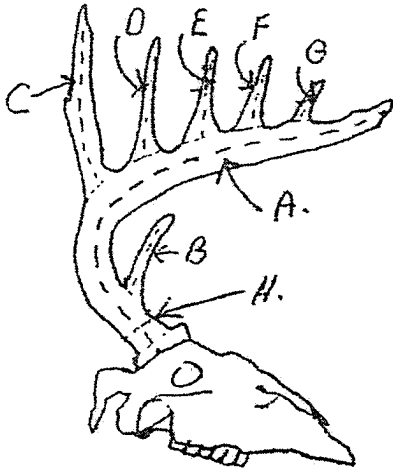

**FOR BIGGEST WHITETAIL DOE AWARD:** Attach a legal locker slip with name and address of locker and weight, and a close-up picture.

**FOR BIGGEST WHITETAIL BUCK:** Attach a close up picture and the following basis measurements:

**FOR LARGEST MULEDEER BUCK TROPHY:** Use same basic measurements and requirements as for Whitetail Buck Trophy.

**FOR BEAR, TURKEY, COYOTE:** Awards given for each animal shot. Submit a close-up picture.

**FOR MOOSE, CARIBOU, ELK, AND PRONGHORN ANTELOPE:** Submit a close-up picture. Awards will be given at the banquet.

**FOR LARGEST MULEDEER shot,** there is a clubhouse traveling trophy.
