SMALL GAME RULES

1. You must be a Waukegan Bowmen Club Member continuously during the period points are accumulated.
2. Small game may be taken in or out of the state of Illinois.
3. Each kill must be legal and taken under fair chase rules and legal seasons except when conditions are special to the Waukegan Bowmen Club.
4. The form must be filled out for each kill. When 40 points are accumulated send the form to the Vice president of the Waukegan Bowmen Archery Club. The awards will be presented at our Big Game Banquet.
5. Except for 30 point group, no more than 20 points can be counted toward an award in any other category.
6. In order to win an award you have to have an accumulation of 40 points.
7. Points for small game are as follows:

30 Points

BIG GAME RULES (Deer, Turkey, Coyote, and larger animals)

1. Applicant must have an active membership before game is shot.
2. Game can be shot in or out of any legal state where big game can be taken.
3. In the case of taking a deer, it should be weighed by a person who has a legal scale and the application signed by that person. This is for biggest deer shot award (Biggest Doe, Biggest Buck).
4. Club members entering big game are subject to an award.
5. Any contest blank not filled in full will be discarded.
6. Applications postmarked later than midnight January 8th, will not be eligible for awards.
7. Any big game shot and reported according to the above rules may be entered whether it has been entered in and/or won in any other event.
8. Turn your application in to the Vice-President of your club.

CLUB CARP CONTEST

Rules are as follows:

1. Contest runs from April 1st through August 31st.
2. Applicant must have an active membership before fish is shot.
3. Carp can be shot in any legal water in or out of the state of Illinois.
4. Fish must be weighed to the nearest ounce by a person who has a legal scale and application must be signed by the person weighing the fish.
5. The contest will be based on points. One point for each pound and one point for each inch. The points will be based on the nearest inch or pound.
6. A member can enter as many fish as they wish.
7. Incomplete contest blanks will be discarded. This includes weight, length, and kind of fish.
8. Any fish shot and reported according to the above rules may be entered whether or not it has been entered in and/or won any other contest.
9. Each entry becomes eligible for a WAUKEGAN BOWMEN Carp shooter award if the entry weighs 10-20-30-40 or 50 pounds.
10. Only one prize may be one by the same person each year.
11. Please turn in all application blanks to the club Vice-President.
